—Owing to the fact that the new Carnegie library is to be erected on the present site of the Petoskey Rug Mfg. Co., Ltd., which they have occupied for the past ten years, the company has secured a seven and one-half years' lease of the large property and building of the A. Booth Packing Co., near the dock. Upon the removal of the Booth people's interests to Charlevoix, the rug company will rent the buildings to accommodate their several growing industries in the manufacture of the now famous "Sanitary rugs from old carpets" and "New wools." The added space will also allow a much improved outfit for the carpet cleaning service, with the addition of an entirely new process for handling fine carpets and rugs. The present building Mr. Washburn will have torn down, and will use the same in erecting their new location, nearly all of which will be utilized by the business.
